

# AMCA EUROPEAN CHAPTER NEWSLETTER "Having fun with old motorcycles"

# Hello AMCA Europe Members,

We really bounced back this year after two dry years for old motorcycle events. My bucket list had several items ticked off, with the Banbury Run completed on my 1929 Henderson, the West Kent Run on the 1954 Nimbus, and my 1914 Douglas completing the Pioneer Run even if I was not on it. I had successful knee surgery to correct damage from an old bike crash, The Knucklehead Years book series was published, and I now have solar panels on the roof. Phew! For next year I have an Autocrime day planned with the VMCC, to detect engine and frame number alterations, and an invitation to the Black Hills Road Run in September. For our European Meet I am searching for a WW1 dispatch rider uniform for the Douglas, as our theme is 'War Bikes'. The costume will also work for the Oude Klepper Parade and the Goodwood Revival, so there should be lots of fun with old motorcycles next year.

This newsletter is mostly about plans for 2023, and our Country Ambassadors have supplied the details. Some of the events later in the year are still tentative, so please check first. We have two European Road Runs for special recommendation.

# Skagen Run

Here in Denmark we have our biggest Vintage Run called "Skagenløbet" for pre 1935 bikes. We will be around 160-200 bikes. This year we drive from Skagen to Copenhagen from the 18 may to 20 may. We cross whole Denmark in 3 days by the best small roads in the country and a lot to see on the trip. Total distance will be around 700-800 km. There are no mountains to climb and the roads are quiet, so firsttimers should have a great run. This year the run clashes with our Raalte Meet, so choices will have to be made.

# Italian Run

It will not be an official AMCA Road Run, but a smaller event organized by Fabio and Cristiano from Patina Garage and the local Langhe Hills Chapter Italy.

Patina Garage and Langhe Hills Chapter Italy invite all AMCA members to participate in their Road Run.

Date of the Road Run: May 28 – June 2, 2023. Provisional Schedule:

- Arrival of the participants at Patina Garage Italy (Pianfei CN) in the evening of Sunday 28 May. Accommodation in a local hotel.

- Run will start from Patina Garage on Monday 29 May at 8:00 with a tour through the Wineland, returning in the evening to the same hotel.

- Tuesday 30 May departure at 8:00 towards Provence, accommodation in a hotel located in the Gorges du Verdon area. - Wednesday 31 May departure at 8:00 to San Tropez with evening event at Patina Garage France in Ramatuelle.

- Thursday 1 June relaxing day on the French Riviera; sightseeing at typical villages of the area.

- Friday 2 June return to Patina Garage Italy on a different route. Closing event in the evening for all participants.

There will be two rescue vehicles and two spare motorcycles in case of breakages. Medical assistance is provided along the entire route.

For visitors from Overseas there will be a limited number of bikes available that can be picked up at Patina Garage, Italy.

Participation on the Road Run is limited. AMCA members only. All riders must be registered by March 15, 2023. A down payment of € 150 (via PayPal) will be due at the time of registration.



# **European Chapter Meet**

Our Meet this year is a week earlier at May 19-20 so put this in your diary now! Here is the flyer.

The theme is Military Bikes, and I know we have plenty in our Chapter, so please bring them out. All motorcycles more than 35 years old are of course welcome. If you want to enter a bike for judging, please note that all machines must now be preregistered with a 21 day lead time, so there will be no on-site registration.

### Judging

Just to repeat, the AMCA National has decided there will be **no ride-in judging this year**, only after preregistration with a 21 day deadline before the Meet. Register for \$15 on the Club Website.

Other rule changes for 2023 are a demanding 98 point Marque Excellence award for existing Winners Circle motorcycles wanting to enter, and a concession that returning Winners Circle bikes need not be started as they are for display, although they must still make 85 points minimum.

You can download the latest rule book from the Club Website, and I'll be bringing a few printed copies to our show in May.
