Eightieth D-Day Anniversary

Yes, the military guys are lining up for the celebrations next June, so get your bike fettled and accommodation booked in good time. Here's something I saw locally:



It's a 1942 Welbike, designed in secret at Welwyn in Hertfordshire, and intended to be dropped in a parachute container. The commandos are then supposed to unfold and pin the handlebars and seat in about 15 seconds so it looks like this:



With a push start it is then ridden to the front line on the 98 cc two stroke engine, with about a quart/litre of fuel and then abandoned. About 3,000 were built, with many surplused as pit bikes or farm transport as there is no front brake. If that is not to your taste, how about this 1940 Matchless G80 in original paint?



The Panhead Years

After the VL Years and the Knucklehead years, it was inevitable that my next project would be the Panhead Years. This is another non-commercial book series to make period literature available to the next generation. With 18 years of Harley-Davidson Panheads (1948-65) this will be six nearly 500 page volumes covering three years each, and containing every dealer announcement, sales brochure, and Enthusiast magazine, with some technical commentary and pictures of good bikes.
