

# AMCA EUROPEAN CHAPTER NEWSLETTER "Having fun with old motorcycles"

# Hello AMCA Europe Members,

There were no shows for me to attend over the winter, but perhaps some of you were working on restoration projects. Please send me your stories for next time. Meanwhile, we look at the results of the big Las Vegas auction, review judging developments, welcome new members, and again remind you of our May meeting in Raalte.

#### **Auction Results**

The Mecum auction in late January in Las Vegas gives a snapshot of what is happening in the old bike world. The top ten results will already be known, but the star was \$935k for a 1908 Harley-Davidson. Values include the 10% buyers premium. A 1938 Vincent Series A twin fetched \$330k, with two 1925 BMWs making \$220k each. After that it was four cylinder motorcycles, with two ACEs, two Hendersons, a Zundapp K800 and an Indian 402 fetching from \$214k to \$159k.

Even at these rarefied levels there were unsold machines with six figure bids on them, and I sensed a certain optimism in setting reserve values. There were also fifteen collections included in the sale, as the older guys take the money while there are still younger guys out there to buy. In a 5-day sale of over 1500 motorcycles, some prices were hard to explain and a keen buyer with plenty of money, transport, and storage space could have filled a barn with well priced motorcycles.

There were plenty of smaller bikes under \$2000 if you need a starter antique. Several small Hondas went cheaply and a couple of 1960s Benlys could have made more. Bikes that caught my eye were a 1928 ohv Harley peashooter at \$50k, a 1923 Indian Powerplus at \$40k, two 1973 Triumph Hurricane triples at \$20k and \$22k, a nice military 42WLA at \$35k, and a Weslake speedway mount at under \$4k. Custom bikes were out of favour, with a 2005 Arlen Ness chopper at \$15k and several others unsold. My constant tip for a budget four cylinder antique still works, with a 1950s Ariel Square 4 fetching \$12k. If you want speed on a budget, a Suzuki Hayabusa fetched \$7k and one of those monstrous 3 cylinder Triumphs the same amount.

There were plenty of Harleys sold, with Hummers, Scats, Pacers, M-90s and Toppers all present among the V-twins.

Nostalgia was in the air, as two bidders took a 1954 Allstate 175 up to \$16k, while there must have been a similar tussle for a Yamaha FS1E to make \$13k. Commonsense seems to have returned to the Harley knuckleheads, with six sold under \$50k each, four of them '47s. There were 1937, '38 and '39 ULs sold for reasonable prices, possibly to reappear as early knuckleheads next time.


You can log on to the Mecum website and spend time on might-have-beens with 61 pages of auction results, but at this event it seems to me as if buyers and sellers were pretty evenly matched.

#### Judging News

On 19 January, Club President Ross Metcalfe asked me to stand in as Chief Judge for the next season or so, and that gave me plenty to do. The new Judging Handbook has been approved by our Board and posted on the Website, and is worth a read for all those interested in factory correct motorcycles. Pete Reeves and I will be bringing hard copies to Raalte for our judges' back pockets. We've redrafted the guidance to Event Chief Judges, Chapter Deputy Judges and Judging Administrators and circulated them to all concerned. We have now completed judging at the Nebraska and Florida Meets, with x bikes successfully judged.
