

# AMCA EUROPEAN CHAPTER NEWSLETTER "Having fun with old motorcycles"

May 2023

## Hello AMCA Europe Members,

This time I report quickly on our fabulous European National Meet at Raalte, before heading off for the Italian Chapter Road Run next week.

## European Meet 19/20 May 2023

I followed my usual routine Thursday 18th, with an early start, breakfast on the Dover ferry, then about 500 km north east from Calais through France and Belgium to Raalte in the Netherlands. Again as usual I arrived mid-afternoon to find most of the set-up work had been done by our team of volunteers, with Martin van Kuijk, Dave van der Linden and Manfred Krause in the thick of it.

As we unloaded, I met Club President Ross Metcalfe and wife Kris, here for the first time. Ross remarked later that our Raalte get-together reminded him of a US Meet 25 years ago, which I'm sure he meant as a compliment. As it turned out, the trade stands were filled with essentially 100% American bike parts, and if you needed a special piece it was almost certainly here somewhere. Our youngest bike in for judging was a 1947 knucklehead, so you can see we are distinctly old school.

Friday saw more arrivals and a busy day at the swap meet, with many visitors enjoying a beverage in the sunshine while enjoying the many military bikes present as our theme. The on-site hotel was booked out, the two restaurants were busy, and many enjoyed a visit to Max Middelbosch' American Motorcycle Museum.

Saturday was judging day, with 14 bikes reviewed, all Harleys and Indians except for my 1914 Douglas. This was not judged last year but this time we found judges and it received its Junior First award, but those pesky judges gave it a quarter point hit for incorrect

period friction tape holding down the rubber tubing for the acetylene lamps – pah!

Ross put in a shift judging the Canadian WLC Harley bikes entered for judging, plus the rare 42 ELC knuckle. He remarked on the high quality of the bikes entered, and the amazingly detailed knowledge of our European judges. Here's Pete Reeves' 42 ELC, the only bike to make Winners Circle this year:



From Sweden came this unrestored 1915 Eagle:



This used the Spacke engine, like the Dayton and Sears, with 1915 being their last year.

We had three Indians in for judging, an early little twin and two fours. Here's a beautiful 1940 four cylinder brought over from Germany.



Not in for judging, but another rare and beautiful bike, was the 1936 Harley 'Black Pearl' first year knucklehead, with owner Fritz Martin telling me an interesting story of its history, with photos of it in service over the years.



We finished the serious business around noon, so an hour later had time to assemble the military motorcycles for pictures and many social media postings. In the next column is me dressed as a WW1 dispatch rider on the 1914 Douglas, many of which were used in France. 1914 is the first year with no pedals, so the bikes are started by paddling along and then dropping the valve lifter.

Below that is a picture of some of the 50-100 bikes at the show, with our Club President in the white shirt, and me next to him still in the military uniform.





Our final piece of business on Saturday was our Annual General Meeting at 1600 h. This started with my Chapter Presidents report, showing 359 European members plus four signed up at the Meet, making a new record for us of 363 AMCA people in Europe, thanks to the hard work of our Country Ambassadors in recruiting and retaining members. Max Middelbosch was thanked once more for making us so welcome, with Claudia and Manfred, Martin and Mika, Jan and Petra, Tina and Claudia recognised for their hard work on administration which made everything go so smoothly.

I remarked that the 'fellowship of a common interest' in old motorcycles cuts across national barriers, and this year we set another new record with visitors from 22 different countries. If you know your abbreviations these were A, B, CAN, CZ, DK, EST, FIN, F, D, IS, IRL, I, NL, N, PL, P, SK, E, S, SZ, USA and UK.

We then had election of Directors, with those currently holding office prepared to stand for another year and being elected by acclamation.

Date of next meeting was set as Ascension Day weekend next year, being 11/12 May 2024, with our theme being Overhead Valves.

President Ross then said some very nice words about the Meet, followed by our judging awards. Most Unique went to Alex Gondrand from France with this 1959 Vespa military rocket launcher, yes, they really made them:



That is Ross Metcalfe in the white shirt looking suitably amazed.



Oldest bike went to this 1902 Werner from Hans Devos in Belgium:

And best restored went to Jaap Hoekstra for his immaculate 99.75 point 42WLA Type VI.



Longest distance driven was taken by Kurt Thrue, who had driven 700 km from Holstebro in Denmark on his 1947 Harley knucklehead, while lady rider Buf Poelma was rewarded for coming 103 km from Utrecht on her 1943 WLC Harley.

After this we attended the hotel barbecue or the restaurant dinner next door, told lies, drank beer, and danced to the band until late. Next morning it was breakfast, book the hotel for next year, and head off back home. What a great time we had!
